TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Preamble

In accordance with the Constitution/By-laws of the Association of Engineering Technicians and Technologists of NL, a Member is granted the privilege of using the **AETTN Certified Member Identification Stamp**. The use of the stamp acknowledges that a certified technician/technologist accepts responsibility for the integrity of the work performed. It will promote pride of authorship and a distinct sense of achievement for those who have met the applicable standards.

Eligibility

The use of the stamp is restricted to a Member in good standing who is registered in one of the following full member categories: Certified Technician; Certified Engineering Technician; Certified Engineering Technologist; Applied Science Technologist

As a guideline the stamp may be affixed on the following documents:

- (1) Preliminary and final technical drawings. (Preliminary drawings should be clearly marked with a statement to note their preliminary nature.)

- (2) Preliminary and final reports. (Preliminary reports should be clearly marked with a statement to note their preliminary nature.)
- (3) Lab analyses.
- (4) Maps.
- (5) Specifications.
- (6) Design and field notes.
- (7) Official field notes.
- (8) Official estimates.
- (9) Plans.
- (10) Appraisals.
- (11) Permits.

Letters would not come under this category unless used as a report.

In some instances, the industry practice is to stamp original drawings. In some instances, only copies are stamped. The member must be aware of the accepted practice in his/her area.

Costa/Acquisition

Acquisition of the stamp may only be made through the Association's office, upon completion of this application form, and payment of the prescribed fee (\$50.00) in effect at the time of submitting the application for processing.

Ownership of the stamp remains the property of the Association and must be surrendered forthwith upon demand or upon ceasing to be a member in good standing for any reason. The charge levied to obtain the stamp is an administrative and trademark license fee for the processing and fulfillment of the stamp request and for the use of the stamp, and does not constitute an actual purchase of the stamp nor the transfer of any ownership rights. This non-refundable fee is a one-time charge, which permits the member to use the stamp so long as they remain a Member in good standing, and so long as its use is not restricted by any disciplinary action of the Association. By maintaining possession of the stamp, it is construed that the member continues to agree with all current promulgated conditions and requirements associated with its use.
