Criteria and Application

The Association of Engineering Technicians and Technologists of Newfoundland and Labrador "**Lloyd Murchy CET**" Scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 will be awarded to students who are residents of Newfoundland and Labrador and who meet the following criteria, in the order of precedence shown:

1. Parent or legal guardian is a member in good standing of AETTNL
2. Is enrolled in an Applied Science/Engineering Technology program that is accredited by the Canadian Technology Accreditation Board (CTAB), or accepted by AETTNL as leading to membership in the association.
3. Is a student member in good standing of AETTNL

After meeting these criteria, selection will be based (in order of precedence shown) on:

1. High academic achievement: Specifically the highest total of all marks on the final transcript of the year's work.
2. Involvement in extracurricular activities.
3. Community or volunteer service.

The deadline for applications is the close of business of the office on September 15th. (Or the closest previous business day).

The successful applicant will be announced at the annual general meeting of AETTNL.
