AETTNL Scholarship

AETTNL offers a minimum of four (4) and up to six (6) annual scholarships of \$500 each, to students enrolled in a nationally accredited Technician or Technology program. AETTNL scholarships recognize and reward academic excellence displayed by AETTNL student members.

To be eligible to apply for an AETTNL scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- be a registered student member, in good standing, with AETTNL,
- be enrolled, as a full time student, in a Technician or Technology program accredited by the Canadian Technology Accreditation Board,
- be in his/her second or third year of study in the accredited program,
- have a minimum academic grade point average (GPA) of 3.0

Award of scholarships will be based on academic merit. The successful candidates will be selected by members of the AETTNL Scholarship Committee.
